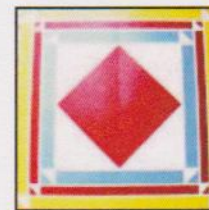


Stitches In Time



Appalachian Quilt Trail Challenge 2012

The Appalachian Quilt Trail leads visitors across East Tennessee with over 470 stops and waypoints. The trail not only brings visitors closer to the natural beauty of the region and its local businesses, but it also introduces them to the art of quilting and passing favorite quilt patterns down from generation to generation. In 2010 Bradley County joined the Appalachian Quilt Trail with 12 wooden quilt squares installed on barns and places of business from downtown to the countryside. This 2012 Quilt Challenge celebrates Bradley County's important mark on the Appalachian Quilt Trail and our local quilt heritage.

GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY

Submit a small quilt or wall hanging that is inspired by one of the Quilt Blocks on the Appalachian Quilt Trail in Bradley County selected from the attached quilt designs. For information on the squares, visit <http://www.visitclevelandtn.com/www/docs/1210/>. We encourage you to drive the Trail as well and see the quilt blocks in person.

1. The sum of all sides of the quilt must be less than 240 inches.
2. Quilter may use any method of piecing and quilting such as strip piecing, paper piecing, appliqué, free motion or hand embroidery, etc.
3. Quilts must be quilted and bound.
4. Challenge piece must have an identifying label attached to the back. If more than one person worked on the finished quilt, the label should indicate this. Label should also identify the Bradley County Appalachian Quilt Trail Block from which it is inspired.
5. Entries must be dropped off at the Museum from January 2-14, 2012, Monday - Friday, 10 am-5 pm & Saturday, 10 am-3 pm.
6. Quilts will be on display at the Museum Center for the duration of the 2012 Stitches-In-Time quilt exhibit (dates to be announced but roughly late January through early March).

All judge's decisions are final.

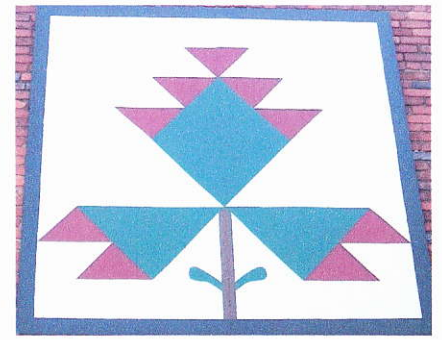

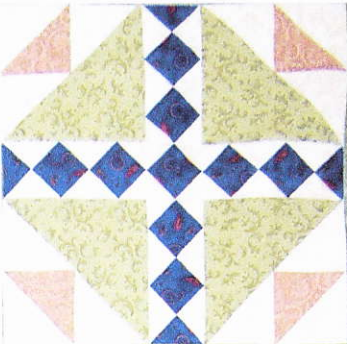

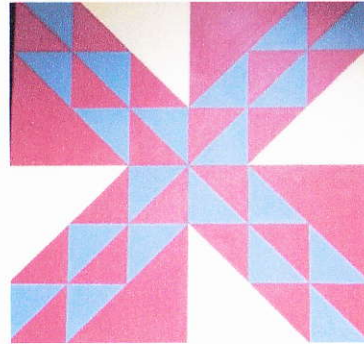

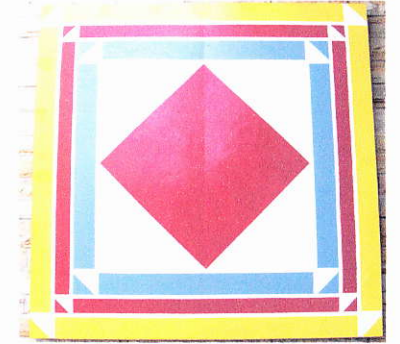

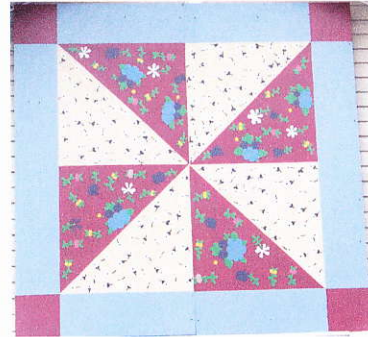
